Annual Troop Events

There are several events throughout the year in which Troop 41 traditionally participates.

SUMMER CAMP

Troop 41 always attends a Boy Scout summer camp. This is a weeklong event which that takes place at different Boy Scout camps around the Pacific Northwest. It usually has a high percentage of the Troop participating and is a favorite of parents as well. It offers a unique opportunity for Scouts to interact and compete with other Troops, work on multiple Merit Badges and Rank advancement. Summer Camp is where many Scouts will have experiences they will remember for a lifetime.

50 MILER

Another highlight for many Scouts is completing a "50-miler". This is, as the name suggests, a multi-day 50-mile journey. This event involves camping, hiking and often for Troop 41, canoeing and kayaking. This experience has been a near annual undertaking but is only open to Scouts above the age of 13. Like summer camp, this adventure can take nearly a week and requires adult commitment.

- Jamboree on The Air (JOTA) A weekend camp trip featuring amateur radio contact with other Scouts across the country and individuals around the globe (mid-October)

CANOEING AND KAYAKING

Troop 41 is always looking for opportunities to hold events involving paddling (50 milers, family camp, etc.). We are fortunate to have several canoes and kayaks (and a trailer) to make this happen. The Troop 41 motto is "Get to the Point" coined during a fifty-miler canoe trip.

Outdoor Adventure – Camping and Hiking

Troop 41 does as much outdoors as possible including many hiking and camping trips. We are lucky to live in an area surrounded by natural beauty and countless locations to do this. Because these activities are so central to Scouting Troop 41 takes full advantage of our location.

HIKING

Some favorite local hiking trails include Lime Kiln trail, Monte Cristo, Lord's Hill, and the urban Seattle History trail. Going a little further, the Troop has visited the Ape Caves near Mt. St. Helens among other State favorites. We have recently been placing more emphasis on "backpack" hiking/camping trips where Scouts pack in/out all gear for the weekend.

CAMPING

Beyond the traditional summer camp. Troop 41 also tries to have local camp outs roughly once per month. This includes the annual events noted above like JOTA and MBE and other opportunities for Scouts to home their camping skills and meet rank and merit badge requirements. Typical locations include BSA camps Pigott, Edward, and Freeman.
